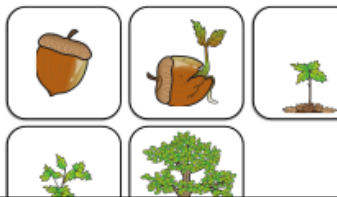

Posters come in color and blackline.

Sequencing Cards

Print and laminate the color set. These can be displayed in a row on a wall to show the sequence, or cut them apart to use as cards the children can sequence. For younger children, you may want to only use 3 of the cards. Use the blackline set to print multiple copies for students.

Books

The bigger, full-color books included are non-fiction fact books about the life cycles. They can be shown on a computer projector to a whole group or print out and assemble to make a print book.

The blackline little reader is a condensed version of the bigger book. You can print multiple copies of these for students.

Photo Cards

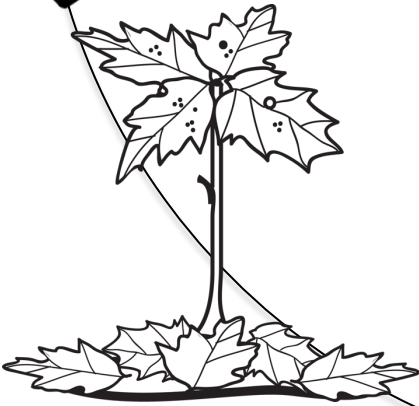
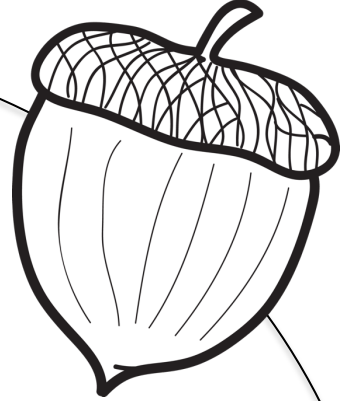
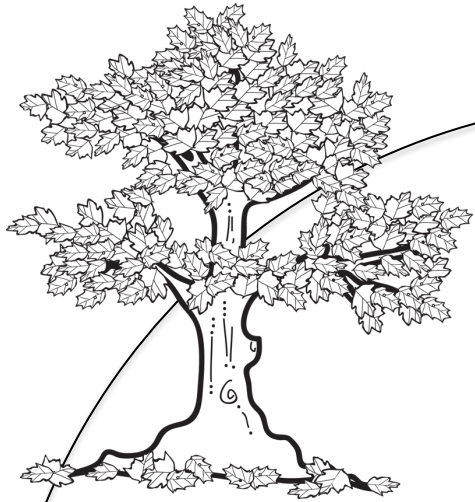

Seed



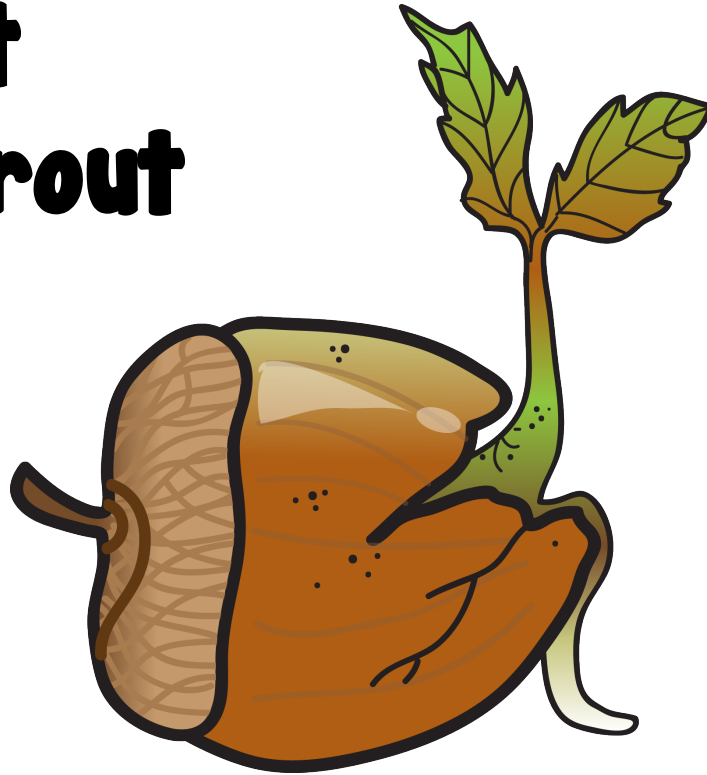
The oak tree starts life as a seed, called an acorn. The acorn has food for the tree inside. This food is also healthy food for some animals.

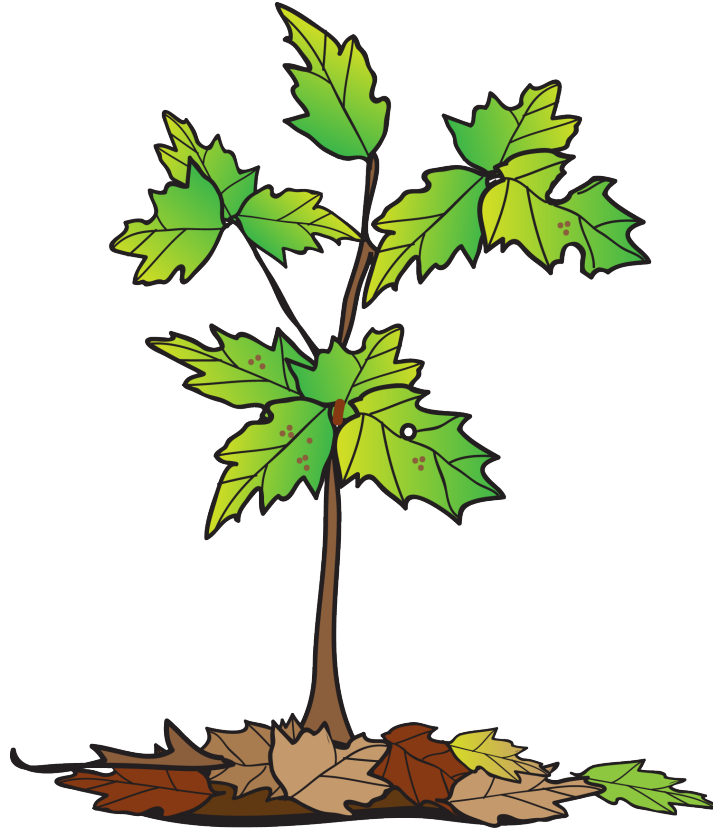
