

Emergency Lesson Plans

Circle Time:

Letter/Number Basketball:

Write letters or numerals on several pieces of paper. Make enough papers for each child, plus one or two extra. Make a line with masking tape on the floor and place the trash can about 4 feet away. As each child has a turn, tell them which letter to find. They pick up the letter, crumble the paper into a ball, and stand on the tape to toss it into the trash can. If they miss, they get as many chances as needed to get the "ball" in the basket and can move closer if needed.

Small Group:

Counting:

Materials: Set of numeral cards (located in Math Center), set of math counters (located in Math Center)

Procedure Give each child a numeral card. Ask them to identify the numeral and count out the correct amount of math counters to place on the card.

Bingo:

Materials: Choose a set of Alphabet or Shape bingo (located in the Literacy or Math Center); Unifix cubes (located in Math Center) Procedure: Use a set of Unifix cubes to cover each letter/shape on the bingo cards. Play until each child has covered all letters/shapes on their bingo mat.

Painted Letters:

Materials: paint, paper, paintbrushes (located in Art Center)
Procedure: Write a letter on a sheet of paper in pencil. Have the children trace over the letter with paint.
