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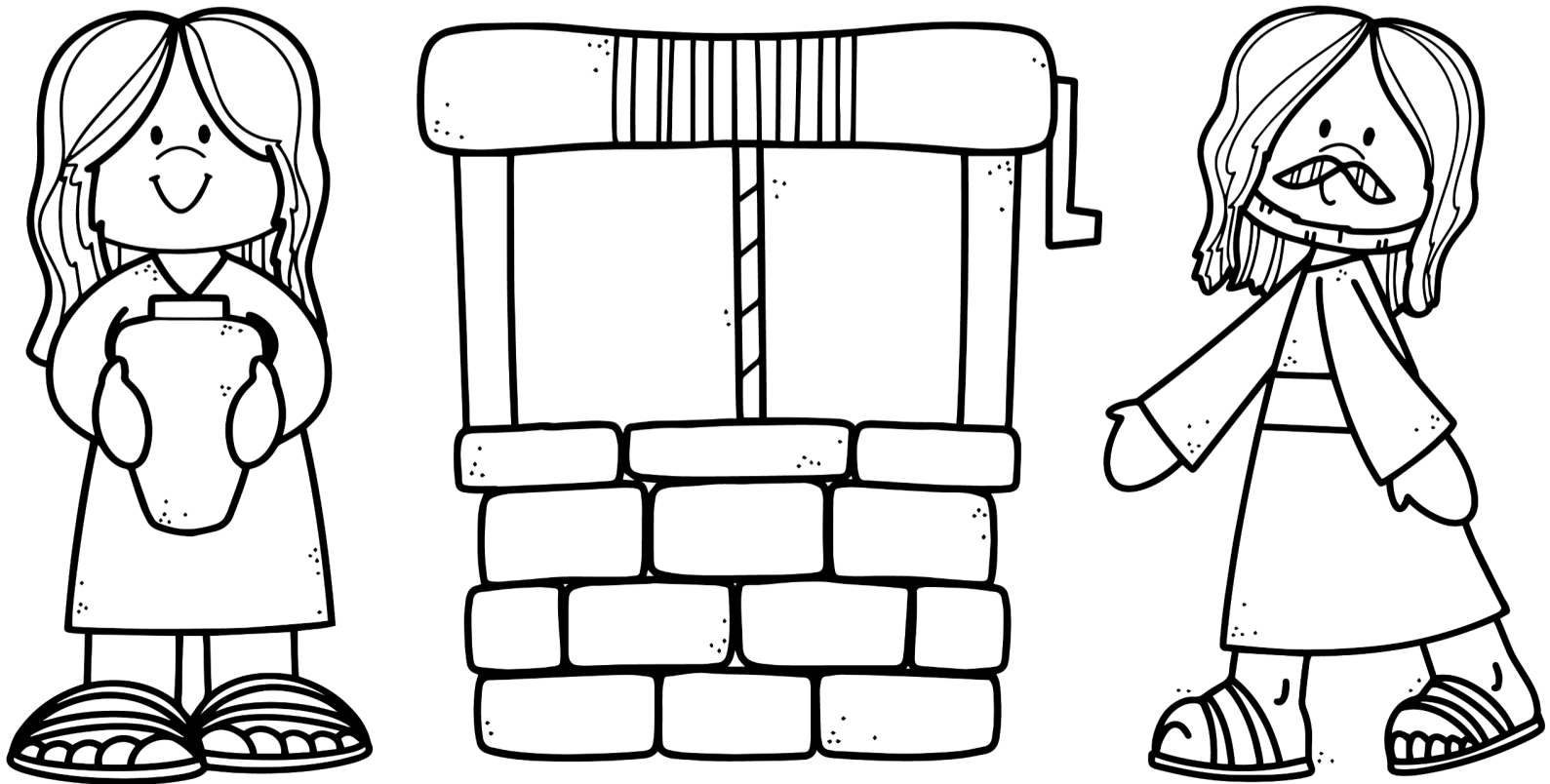
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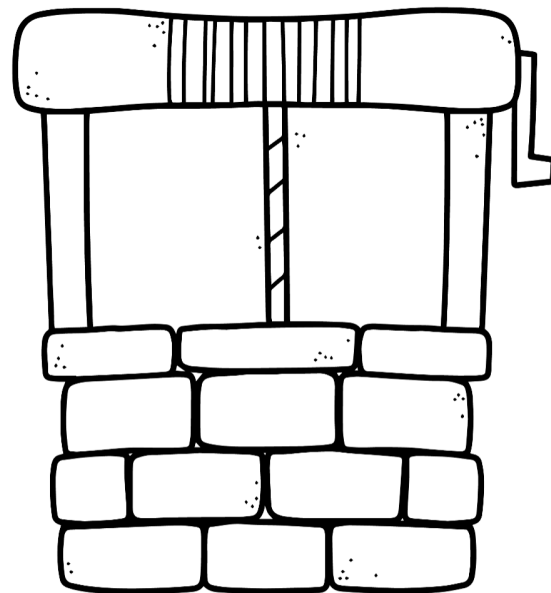
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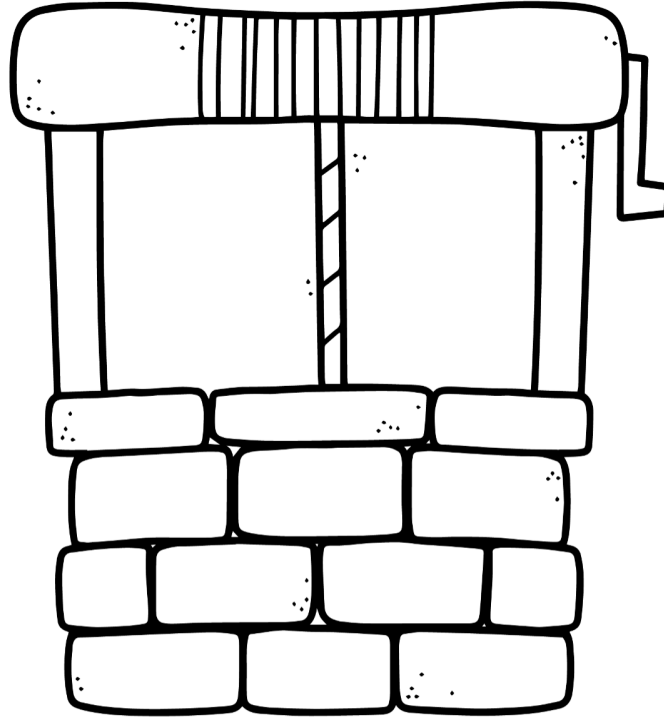
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Jesus and the Woman at the Well

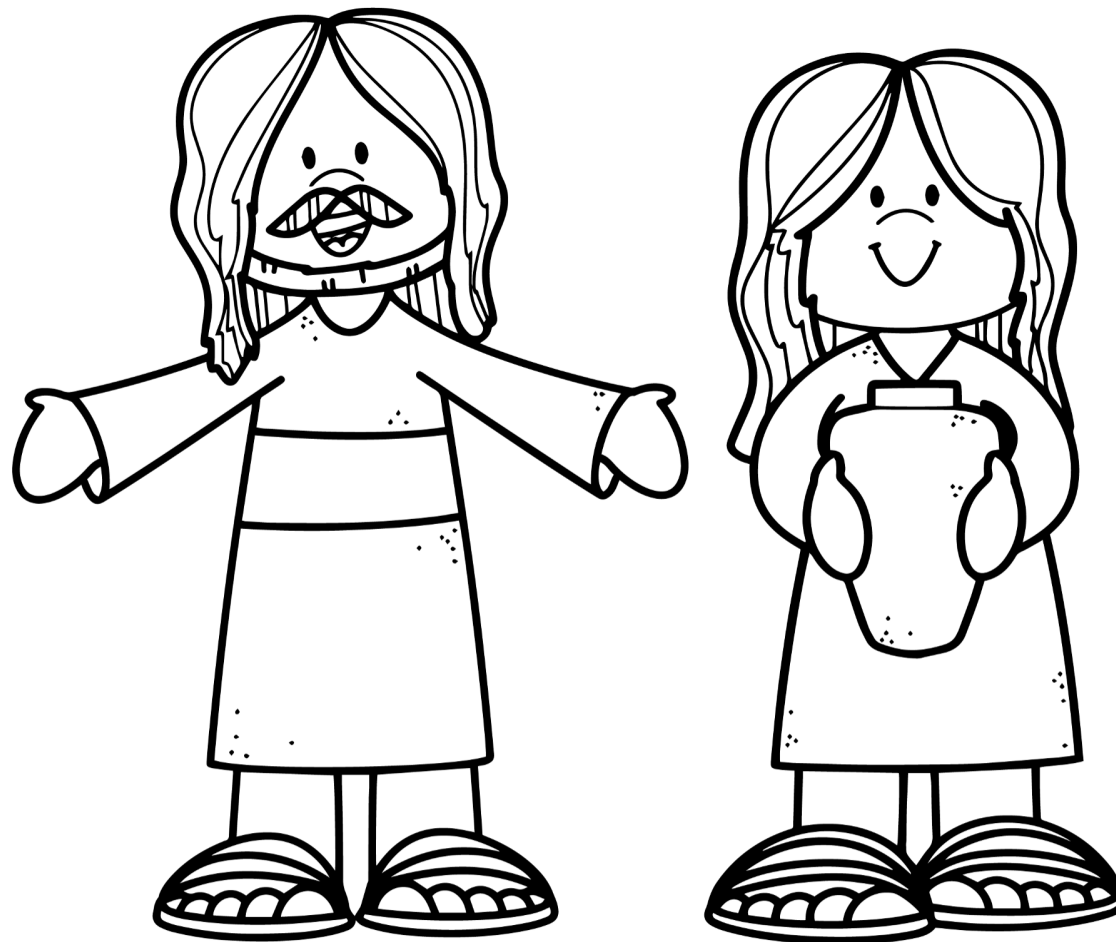




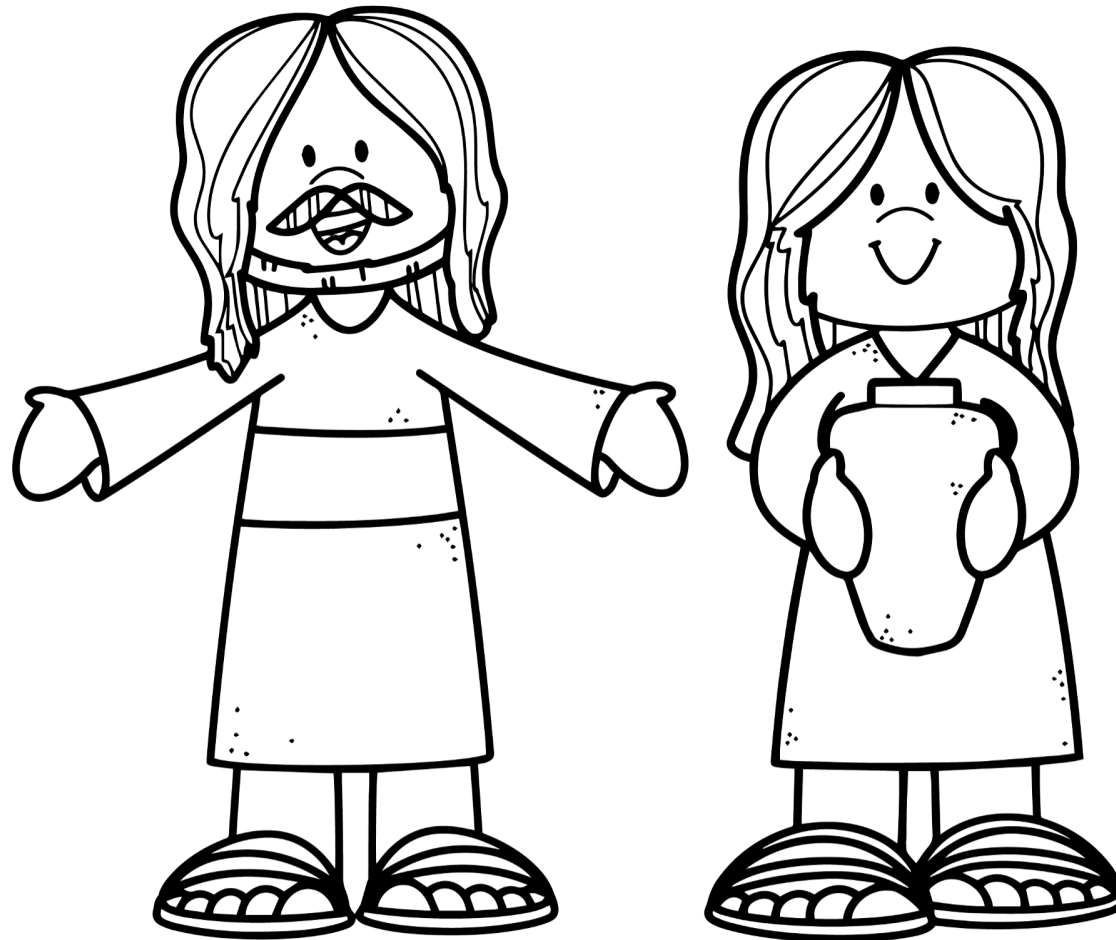
One day, Jesus was traveling with his disciples, walking through a place called Samaria. Jesus was tired from walking a long way, so he stopped and sat down by a well.



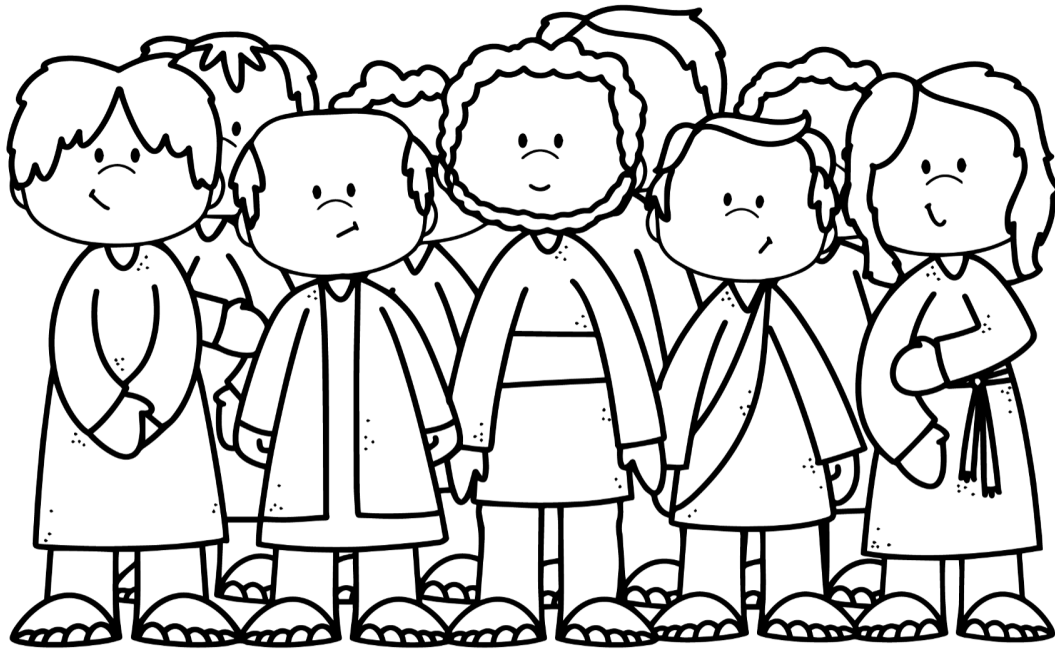

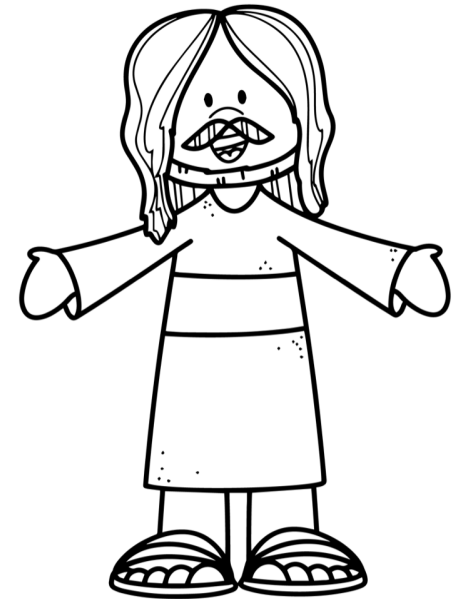
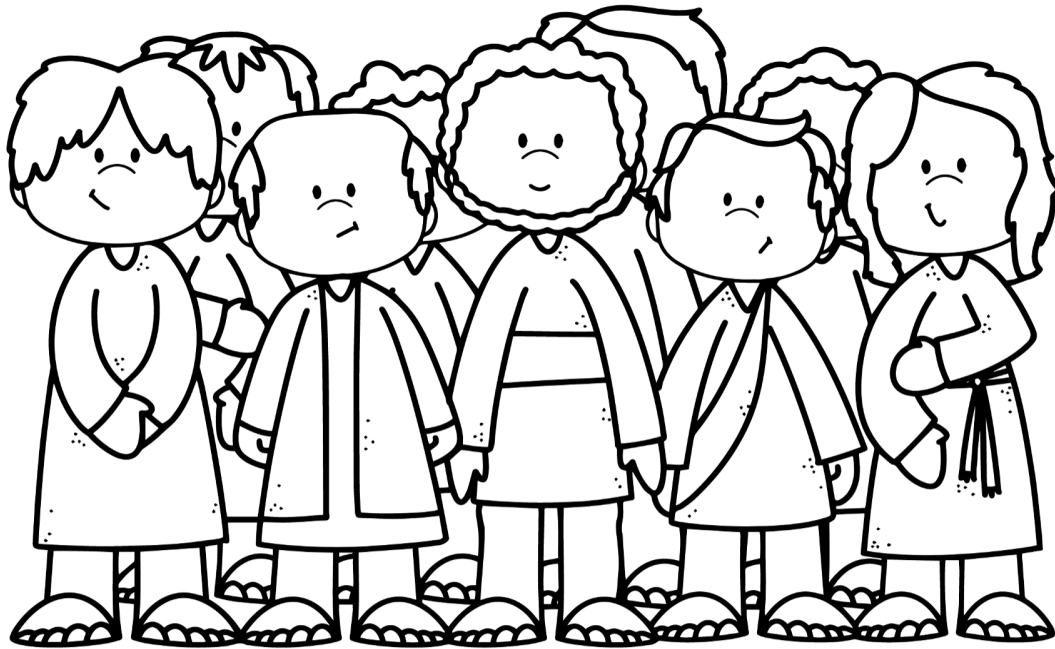
